

Articulation of Transfer & 2 + 2 Guaranteed Admissions Program Agreement

Between

Wisconsin Technical College System & Silver Lake College of the Holy Family
February 2015

Silver Lake College (SLC) guarantees admission to students who have successfully completed an Associate Degree in Nursing (AAS) degree from one of the 16 Colleges in the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS). All qualified students must have at least a 2.0 Grade Point Average to be admitted to Silver Lake College. In addition 70 semester hours of transfer credit will be applied toward a Silver Lake College Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree. Finally, only courses passed with a grade of "C" or better will be accepted for transfer credit.

The residency requirement for graduation from Silver Lake College will be a minimum of 30 credit hours. In addition to completing a minimum of 30 credit hours, all transfer students must demonstrate core-competencies or equivalent curriculum in the College's core requirements. Students must complete a minimum of 120 credits (WTCS + SLC) to complete a baccalaureate degree. It is highly suggested that all graduates of Silver Lake College participate in experiential learning course work prior to graduating. The student will be assigned an advisor in nursing upon matriculation in the nursing program.

All credit bearing course-work with a grade of "C" or better will become part of the student's permanent record at Silver Lake College. No grades will transfer or appear on a Silver Lake College transcript from another institution; only credits earned will be counted and displayed on the student's permanent record.

Once a student is admitted to Silver Lake College, the accepted degree plan is guaranteed to the student even if subsequent changes in the curriculum occur, provided the student has maintained continuous enrollment in the program. Continuous enrollment is defined as completion of one three credit course in each term. There is no maximum time within which the degree must be completed providing a student maintains continuous enrollment.

Information for advising in specific program transfers will be developed and updated by the appropriate departments at Silver Lake College and Wisconsin Technical College System.

Silver Lake College and Wisconsin Technical College System agree to allow the use of their respective names and logos on any promotional materials for advertising the partnership.

Silver Lake College and Wisconsin Technical College System reserve the right to make revisions and/or discontinuances to this partnership agreement if curriculum changes are made.

STUDENT ADMISSION PATHS

Two Paths for Admission to Silver Lake College through the 2 + 2 Agreement:

1. **Guaranteed Dual Admission** - At the point of Admission to Wisconsin Technical College System, the applicant could participate in the Guaranteed Admissions Program. This provides students with assurance and seamless transition to Silver Lake College after successfully completing an AAS Degree with WTCS.
2. **Traditional Path** - A completed admission application and official transcripts must be presented at the time of admission to Silver Lake College, following completion of the Wisconsin Technical College System's Associate Degree in Nursing.

SCHOLARSHIPS

A Silver Lake College academic scholarship will be awarded to any enrolling Wisconsin Technical College System transfer student who has completed one of the above paths. Students must also be enrolled full-time and must complete and submit a FASFA Form to the Office of Financial Aid at Silver Lake College.
